Staffing Updates

Before the Christmas break we held a Parent Governor election. Thank you to those that returned the ballot papers. The ballot closed on Monday and after a very close contest we can inform you that Mrs Claire Abdelaoui has been elected by you to be your new Parent Governor. We wish her luck in her new role. Whilst we are happy to welcome Mrs Abdelaoui, we are also sad that Mr Paul Hussey will no longer be a Parent Governor for Marfleet Primary. On behalf of all staff, governors and pupils we would like to thank Paul for all his hard work and considerable support over the past four years.

Roof Repairs

A team of contractors should be starting on the roof repairs next week. This will mean that scaffolding will be erected in certain areas around school as a health and safety precaution for the men working on the roof. Additionally a container and skip will be located on the verge / pavement outside school. Whilst the day to day running of the school should not be affected, we would ask for your cooperation in ensuring that children keep away from these areas. Access to the school in a morning and at leaving time should not be affected. We have asked the contractors not to park near school so that disruption to our neighbours is kept to a minimum.

Attendance

We have noticed a large amount of children are arriving to school late since our return in September. Whilst we appreciate this is sometimes unavoidable, please ensure you are making the best efforts in getting your children into school on time. We now have a new system in place to make you aware on a weekly basis of how much time your child is missing from their education. You may receive a message via Marvellous Me or a letter.

We must also remind you lateness and absence from school may result in a fixed penalty from the Local Authority. If your child arrives to school past 9.30am they are at risk of having an unauthorised mark.

> Please may we remind you of the timings to arrive to school: Breakfast club – between 8am – 8.30am | Learning starts/doors open – 8.45am | Doors close – 9am

Our whole school attendance target is 96%; I hope we can work together in achieving this. We are currently at 94% therefore we do have a way to go.

Uniform reminder

Marfleet Primary School's uniform is grey bottoms, white polo shirt and a red jumper/cardigan.

False nails or nail varnish is not to be worn by pupils and shoulder length hair must be put up.
