We also have a School Leader for behaviour and wellbeing, based in our treehouse who creates and supports great links between home and school.

Specialist teaching opportunities

As a school we believe that children deserve high quality teaching from staff equipped with specialist training.

As such we have specialist teaching in Music and PE and offer our staff a range of CPD opportunities to ensure they are equipped in delivering a high quality curriculum to all.

Wrap-around care

For those families who need to access extended care facilities, we do offer a breakfast club from 8.00am every morning – the entrance is £1.50 and free for our Pupil Premium children other children just pay for what they have eaten.

We also offer an extensive range of extra-curricular and lunch time clubs for children to enjoy.



Respect

Building positive relationships is at the heart of all we do.

We expect all adults and pupils within the school to respect each other and act with integrity.

We believe that building a firm future involves trust and honesty at all levels.

Admissions
