

Year 1: Why is Pompeii called the Lost City?

Previous learning: Children will revisit their knowledge of Italy from when they roleplayed visiting there in Early Years. They will recap physical and human features from their Local Area topic earlier in the academic year. Children will draw on previous learning experiences of now and a long time ago. They will enhance their making skills by planning and developing a structure, using skills they previously learnt from their crafting in Early Years.
