## Year 6: Mary Q of Scots-What led to the demise of Mary Queen of Scots'?

Previous learning: In Year 5, the pupils learnt about Elizabeth I and the Tudor family tree, in this unit the Year 6 pupils will explore how the Tudor and Stewart families are linked. In Year 5, the pupils learnt how to gather information from primary sources to understand a significant person. In this unit of work the pupils will learn how to use primary sources to compare two significant people. In key stage 2, the pupils learnt how to create and interrupt family trees. In this unit of work the pupils will look at how two families are linked and how they are represented on a family tree. In key stage 2, the pupils explored primary and secondary sources to help them understand the period of history. In Year 5, the pupils evaluate evidence and justify their responses to the information gathered. In Year 1 pupils looked at the difference between Catholics and Protestants and how this affected people in England.
