Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer

Every child receives up to 1 hour of Music teaching a week in our school - it is a spiral, multi-sensory and well sequenced curriculum designed for Marfleet's needs. All pupils - attend our 30 minute **whole-school music assembly** once a week delivered by our Music Specialist - Listening and Singing. The whole school also receive termly Whole Class Ensemble (brass) by Hull Music Service.

- **EYFS pupils** - receive a 20 minute music lesson based on traditional rhyme and song with lots of opportunities to explore instruments, sing and perform.
- **KS1 pupils** - receive a 45 min Music lesson using Jolly Music plus a range of untuned percussion plus lots of singing, composing and music games.
- **KS2 pupils** - receive a 1 hour Music lesson with Hull Music service. Children explore the full range of musical dimensions and have opportunities to play instruments Y4 Pbuzz, Y5 trombone and revisit tuned and untuned percussion. All classes do listening using the MMC, performing, composing & singing too.

Our Music Assemblies

Our Music Assemblies Delivered by our T&L staff, all of our pupils access our weekly 30 minute music assembly with a focus on 'Singing and listening'. Children partake in a weekly warm up based around a music skill, this changes half termly. We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use the time to help our children prepare for our calendar of performances events, with songs that will eventually be performed to an audience either in school or at the local church, St Giles. .

Class Provision includes:

- Tuned and untuned percussion
- Music trolley
- Trombone
- Pbuzz
- Choir
- Charanga
